


Lesson 4 – Picture Use


1. Open Pixlr <https://pixlr.com/>
2. Signin if you plan to save to their site
3. Launch the Web App Pixler EDITOR



4. Create a New Image
5. Choose the Size - can use 800 x 600.



6. Click Type Tool
7. Choose your font and size – large full letters work best
8. Add the text that you want







- Use Move Tool to put the text at the center of the image
- Use the View in the top toolbar so you see the whole canvas




- Click the Type Tool to edit the text.



- Click Layers
- Choose Merge Down




- Double click the lock and turn to a checked box



- Click Layer
- Choose Open Image as Layer
- Choose your image

Note – the layers, be sure you are on the layer you are wanting to edit


- Drag the Layer with your text above the picture layer






19. Surround the Text with using Wand Tool


Hint: If you have a letter like A and R, Do not forget to surround the inner part of it with using Shift Button and Wand Tool



20. Drag and Drop the picture layer above the text layer




21. Use the Erase Tool to delete the background



22. Edit

23. Deselect All





24. Use the Layer Styles to give shadows of your text.

25. Right-click the Finished Layer

26. Merge Down.

27. Save
