- Develop an outline for your speech. You must present (at least) three major points about your topic, and each point must have at least two supporting examples.
- Start with an introduction that creates a need for us to know this information, and preview your outline.
- Wrap your speech up with a conclusion that reviews and summarizes your information.
- Your presentation must include some kind of PowerPoint or Keynote presentation. It can be as simple as a couple of pictures, or as elaborate as embedded video, etc.
- Submit your PowerPoint to the class folder on Google Drive prior to the day of your presentation.
- You will use a remote to advance the slides on your presentation while you speak.
