

Family Tree Project

Part 1A - Family Tree Roughdraft in Class

1. Student will construct a family tree, fictional or real on a piece of paper.
 1. *****WARNING***** DO NOT USE ANY NEGATIVE/BAD People in your slideshow (i.e. dictators, artists of questionable character, etc.)
 2. If you include any teachers or other students, PLEASE ask permission!!!!
 3. It can be funny, but stay in the lines of respectful PLEASE.
 4. I will take points off if I think you are being disrespectful or using people that are not good examples.
2. The family tree must contain 15 family members, including yourself. (16 total). The family tree is based off you. Therefor also include yourself.
4. Each member needs to have:
 - a. First name
 - b. Spanish label (Abuela, hermano, etc.)
 - c. Their age (13 años)
 - d. 2 adjectives to describe
6. Needs to have a Family Name/Title

Part 2 - Presentation (We will work on this after break)

1. Create a slideshow that will go along with your family tree. (Google Slides, or other presentation programs)
- 2.. Each family member needs their own slide containing the following:
 - a. Their first name and who they are to you EN ESPAÑOL (Bob, Mi padre)
 - b. A picture
 - c. Two sentences EN ESPAÑOL describing them.(Use the information you already identified in your rough draft to help you write these.
 - ex. Bob es alto. Bob es moreno.
 - ex. Él es bajo. Él tiene 45 años.
4. Make sure that family slideshow has a title (La Familia Hernandez, etc.)
5. You will present your family tree/slideshow in class. There will be a separate grade for speaking.
