Subject Pronouns

	Singular	Plural
1 st Person	Yo - I	Nosotros, Nosotras - We, We (feminine)
2 nd Person	Tú - You	*Vosotros (Fam.), Vosotras - You All, You all (feminine)
3 rd Person	Él, Ella - He, She *Usted- You (formal)	Ellos, Ellas - They, They (feminine) *Ustedes- You All (formal)

Usted/Ustedes- Formal You & You All

- Use it when addressing someone in authority over me or out of respect
- Ex. Mr. Harmon, Mrs. Howey, the doctor, Grandma, the President, your parents
- Ex. Instead of saying, "<u>Tú</u> eres la profesora." → "<u>Usted</u> es la profesora."
- *****It is THIRD PERSON always!

• Every subject will fit a category, but won't always use a pronoun

Subject	Category
Jane and I Jane y yo	1st Person Plural - Nosotros/as
Bob and you Bob y tú	2 nd Person Plural - Vosotros/as
The boys Los chicos	3 rd Person Plural- Ellos
The books Los libros	3 rd Person Plural - Ellos

1st Person	soy - I am	somos - we are	*All verbs will conjugate for all 6 different categories
2 nd Person	eres - you are (fam)	sois - you all are (fam)	*Knowing the subject pronouns help you decide which conjugation to use
3 rd Person	es - He is, she is, You(for) are	son - they are, you all (for) are
