Singular & Plural

Subject Pronouns

| | Singular | Plural |
|---------------------------|--|--|
| 1 st Person | Yo - I | Nosotros, Nosotras - We, We (feminine) |
| 2 nd Person | Tú - You | *Vosotros (Fam.), Vosotras - You All, You all (feminine) |
| 3 rd Person | Él, Ella - He, She *Usted- You (formal) | Ellos, Ellas - They, They (feminine) *Ustedes- You All (formal) |

Usted/Ustedes- Formal You & You All

- Use it when addressing someone in authority over me or out of respect
- Ex. Mr. Harmon, Mrs. Howey, the doctor, Grandma, the President, your parents
- Ex. Instead of saying, “Tú eres la profesora.” → “Usted es la profesora.”
- *****It is THIRD PERSON always!

Subjects

- Every subject will fit a category, but won't always use a pronoun

| Subject | Category |
|-------------------------|---|
| Jane and I Jane y yo | 1 st Person Plural - Nosotros/as |
| Bob and you Bob y tú | 2 nd Person Plural - Vosotros/as |
| The boys Los chicos | 3 rd Person Plural- Ellos |
| The books Los libros | 3 rd Person Plural - Ellos |

SER -to be

| | Singular | Plural |
|------------|----------------------------------|-----------------------------------|
| 1st Person | soy - I am | somos - we are |
| 2nd Person | eres - you are (fam) | sois - you all are (fam) |
| 3rd Person | es - He is, she is, You(for) are | son - they are, you all (for) are |

*All verbs will conjugate for all 6 different categories

*Knowing the subject pronouns help you decide which conjugation to use
