Subjunctive w/Conjunctions

- Conjunctions are words and phrases that connect other words and clauses in a sentence
 - Ex. And —> y/e, or —> o/u, but —> pero
- Certain conjunctions introduce adverbial clauses -> these describe how, why, when, and where an action takes place
 - Some of these are used to express a hypothetical situation, uncertainty as to whether an action or event will take place, or condition
